PAC Focus Leader Update report:

- **Teacher Focus team: Presented by Kristyl Burkey:**
 1. Kristyl and Rachel held a meeting for volunteers who signed up for the Faculty focused teams to plan out the rest of the year in January. No parents came. Rachel and Kristyl planned out the Faculty meetings and rest of teacher support dates for remainder of the school year.
 2. Kristyl Burkey is going to head up organizing parent volunteers for STARR testing. She will be working with Mrs. Shaw to accomplish this. We will be asking parents to donate snack and beverage items toward a special snack cart for our teachers during testing.
 3. Kristyl Burkey asked for funding (\$75) for the final faculty meeting so PAC could present the teachers with an ice cream sundae bar. It was decided by Dr. Barker and Denise McConnell that we should be able to use funds raised by PAC.
 4. Kristyl Burkey briefly touched on planning and ideas she and Rachel had for Teacher appreciation week and end of school year. More to come on this.

 3. End of the year parties will follow the Holiday party format. They will be planned by the grade reps and will most likely take place during P.E. and include games.
 4. Brandy Low proposed that the Student life branch of the PAC may need more people. PAC to think on this, check by-laws, and discuss more. We will need to officially vote before any decisions are made or people are added.
 5. Brandy Low proposed the idea that PAC may want to create a separate website from ume.org. Something fun, with photos, where parents can connect, which is quick for parents to access and consistently updated.
