## Holy Name Mission Statement

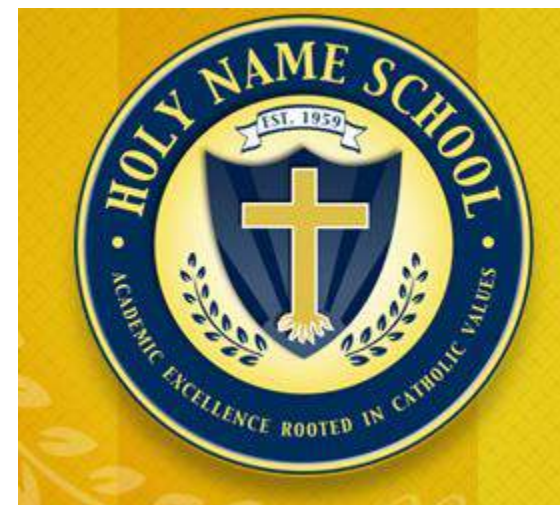
