Dear Parents,

Before sharing information about this coming week, I would like to give some accolades to students and faculty / staff for three events which happened Friday, March 17th.

- As many of you know, it is our custom to have Stations of the Cross prayed on Fridays during Lent. 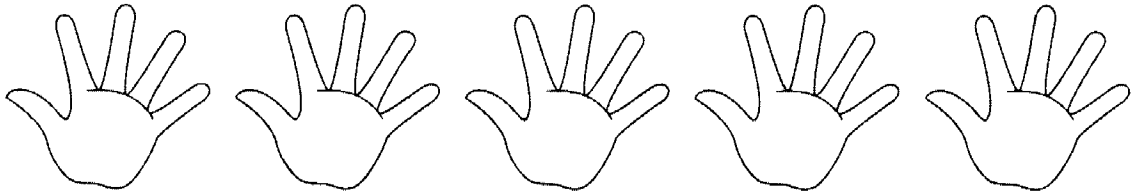

Trace your non-dominant hand, or use the attached template

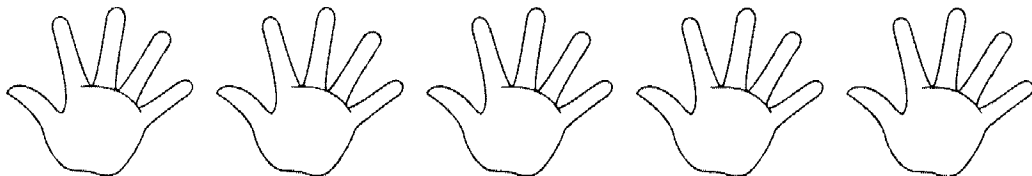
Decorate the inside of your hand with colorful designs or inspiring messages

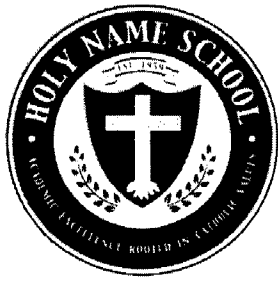
Cut out your hand print and turn into your teacher
