Work Permit Information

- 1. Student must be at least 14 in order to get a Work Permit.
- 2. The student must have been promised/guaranteed a job. In other words, the student MUST have secured a job BEFORE seeking a Work Permit.
- 3. The student is given the Application for Employment Certificate. This form must be completed by the parent(s), employer, and doctor.
- 4. Student must present Proof of Birth. This can be in the form of a Birth Certificate, Driver's Permit / License, Baptismal Certificate, Passport, Affidavit of parent or guardian accompanied by physician's statement (notarized) of opinion as to the age of the student.
- 5. A parent must come to the Main Office and sign the "Work Permits" book.
- 6. Once all of the above steps are completed, the student must bring back to the Main Office the Employment Certificate. At that point, the actual Work Permit will be issued.
