May ISD's Evaluation of Performance In Community and Student Engagement and Compliance

Background

House Bill 5 includes a local evaluation requirement that is frequently referred to as the *community engagement* component. The community engagement requirement is an opportunity for districts to showcase areas of excellence and success as well as recognize areas in need of improvement and set future goals valued in the community.

The statute requires each district to evaluate and designate a performance rating for the district and each of its campuses in the district <u>based on criteria set by a local committee</u> (TEC 39.0545). The law requires that each district and each campus be assigned a rating of exemplary, recognized, acceptable, or unacceptable. The district and campus performance ratings must be reported annually to TEA through PEIMS, and made publicly available by August 8 of each year beginning with the 2013–14 school year.
