


Estrella Vista STEM Academy Arrival & Dismissal Map

Dear Estrella Vista Parents,

Thank you for choosing Estrella Vista STEM Academy for your child's education. To ensure that your child comes to school and leaves each day in the safest manner, we are communicating procedures for parent pick up/drop off, bus routines, and procedures for our walking students.

The locations for various transportation pick-ups/drop offs are:

- Parent pick up/drop off: North parking lot in front of the school
- Bus pick up/drop off: South parking in back of the school
- Walkers/Bikers/Skateboarders: East and West sides of the school

Parent pick up/drop off procedures are as follows:

- Pulling into the North parking lot, please drive on the outer side of the parking spaces
- Pull up as far as you can in order to drop off or pick up your child
- Come to a complete stop, let your children out/in the vehicle and exit drop off/pick up lane in a safe and slow manner
- While in the drop off/pick up lane, please DO NOT park or get out of your car unless you are going to park in the lot, use the crosswalk, and escort your child to and from school

Bus pick up/drop off procedures are as follows:

- Busses will pull in from the Cocopah Avenue entrance on the South side (rear) of the school, line up along the curb facing the school and unload students at approximately 8:15 a.m. to enter school directly.
- During pick up, bus riders will be escorted by a grade level teacher in a safe and orderly fashion.

Walkers

- Students who walk toward the East side of the building will exit out the side door, walk through the playground, and exit out the East gates to the crosswalk.
- Once students are outside the East gates it is expected that they use all pedestrian rules (using crosswalks, not littering, watching for traffic when crossing streets, etc.).
- Students who walk towards the West side of the school will exit out the side of the building through the doors on that end. Students will use all pedestrian rules (using crosswalks, not littering, watching for traffic when crossing streets, etc.) once they have exited the school grounds.
