Kindergarten

- 1 medium backpack
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 2 boxes of 16 Crayola Crayons
- 2 pink erasers
- 1 pkg. of #2 lead pencils
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer
- 1 pair of blunt tip student scissors – Fiskars
- 4 dry Erase Markers
- 1 4 oz. Bottle Elmer’s School Glue
- 1 raincoat or poncho (optional)
- 2 folders w/3 prong fasteners

First Grade

- 1 backpack
- 1 box of 24 count Crayola Crayons
- 1 pair of pointed student scissors – Fiskars
- 1 4 oz. Bottle of Elmer’s School Glue
- 1 box of large Crayola Markers classic colors
- 3 boxes of tissues

(solid colors: colors: green, yellow, blue, red)
- 1 large bottle hand sanitizer
- 2 dry erase markers
