

# CALABASAS DRESS CODE

At Calabasas, we are committed to preparing our students for the future. This preparation includes academic, social and job skills. The classroom is the student's "workplace" and we expect them to dress accordingly. The following dress code is a requirement for all K-8 students:

## SHIRTS / JACKETS:

- Shirts must be solid white, blue, or yellow (During the 2015-16 school year all elementary students will be able to continue to wear red shirts. Beginning the 2016-17 school year, no red shirts will be permitted to be worn by any Calabasas students)
- Shirts must have collars and sleeves, or be a school sponsored spirit shirt
- Middle school students must tuck their shirts in at all times
- Shirts must be no longer than the fingertips with arms resting at the student's shoulders, or tucked in
- Undershirts, sweatshirts, and jackets must be yellow, white, navy blue, or khaki

## PANTS, SHORTS & SKIRTS:

- Khaki (tan), navy blue
- Shorts, Skirts, and dresses must be longer than the student's fingertips with arms resting at the student's side
- Pants must be fitted (no more than 2 sizes larger than the student's body).....Absolutely no baggy pants will be allowed
- All pants and shorts must have a belt or an elastic waist band, and must be worn at the waist.....Absolutely no "sagging" pants will be allowed
- Pants and shorts must be hemmed, without rips

#### I.D.'s:

#### SHOES:

• Must have a back strap for safety reasons

#### HATS:

• No hats allowed

No student shall wear articles of clothing, jewelry (including wallet chains) or accessories, which, in the opinion of the administration, could pose a threat to the physical well being, and safety of the students or others, or disrupt the educational process.
