

Coatimundi Middle School Uniforms & Dress Code Guidelines

Coatimundi Middle School students dress in a professional fashion reflecting pride in themselves and their school. To ensure that these standards are met, the following uniform and dress code policies have been put into place. Students are required to wear the required uniform every day. All shirts **MUST** be tucked in. Clothing should be sized appropriately. Oversized or undersized clothing does not look neat and does not fit acceptable uniform requirements. Students who attend school wearing unacceptable attire will be given a uniform if sizes are available. If an alternate uniform is not available, parents will be notified to bring in uniform clothing before the student can return to class. Repeated offenses for uniform violations can result in lunch or after school detention and possibly suspension.

The following dress code guidelines will be followed by all students at CTMS:

- **Boys & Girls: Bottoms** – Khaki - **Tops** - Red or Black - **Tops must have collars.**
- All shirts must be tucked in. Undershirts, Sweatshirts, and Jackets must be: Red, Black, White, or Khaki (any sweatshirts or jackets that do not meet above guidelines must be removed when entering the classroom)
- All pants and shorts must have a belt or an elastic waist band (make-shift belts are not allowed)
- Clothes may not be more than 2 sizes larger than your body
- No hoods, hats, baseball-type caps, handkerchiefs or other head covering is to be worn while inside school buildings

- I.D. with appropriate lanyard must be worn at all times

Unacceptable Attire

The following types of clothing do not conform to uniform standards: Shorts or skirts above mid-thigh, jeans of any style (including low-rise), denim or corduroy fabrics, sweat pants, bare midriffs, large hoop earrings, open-toed shoes or frayed clothing.

Dress Down Days

Students can earn dress down days for a variety of reasons. Students may come to school in non-uniform appropriate attire when a dress down day is earned.

Updates for the following school year (2014-2015)

- Belts must be black or brown only
- Socks must be solid white, black or red
- Only school issued lanyards will be allowed
- Tampering with your ID in any way is not allowed
- Leggings worn under proper khaki bottoms must be solid white, black or red
