RRHS students have a graduation requirement of 20 hours of “**Responsible Social Involvement**” (**RSI**) per year of attendance. RSI units can be obtained through participation in the school community as well as the greater Santa Cruz Valley community. Students entering RRHS in the middle of an academic year will have a prorated RSI requirement of one hour/per week of attendance. Students who do not complete the required hours on an annual basis will be expected to make up the hours prior to graduation.
