- Tuition at GICC for 2013-2014 is:
\$3,365 for 6-8th grades
\$3,685 for 9-12th grades
\$4,825 not registered in a Catholic parish
Plus \$175 Book Fee per student

Actual cost per student is \$7,000. This difference between the amount paid for each student and the actual cost is made up by Parish Support, the Angel Appeal, Foundation Support and Fundraising.

Individual Retirement Account Charitable Rollover



- Are you age 70 1/2 or older?
- Do you have retirement funds in an Individual Retirement Account (IRA)?
- Do you want to reduce your income tax liability?
- Do you wish to make a charitable contribution to the Central Catholic Development Foundation or Church?

If you answered yes to the above questions, keep reading.

For 2013 only, a popular way to transfer IRA assets to charity is via a tax provision which allows IRA owners who are 70



-1/2 or older to direct up to \$100,000 of their IRA distributions to charity. The money given to the charity counts toward the donor's required minimum distribution, but doesn't increase the donor's adjusted gross income (AGI) or generate a tax bill. Keeping the donation out of the donor's AGI is important because doing so (1) may help the donor qualify for other tax breaks; (2) may reduce taxes on the donor's Social Security benefits, and (3) may assist the donor in avoiding a high-income surcharge for Medicare Part B and Part D premiums (which phase-in if AGI is over certain levels).

This provision is especially beneficial for those who do not utilize itemized deductions but still are paying income tax.
