#### Summary of the Team Meeting:

Dana gave the editor's report. The current editors are on their  $4^{th}$  publication. The online access version of the October issue will be out tomorrow with the call for the NREA research agenda. Dana believes there are enough quality submissions now that the journal can sustain a special issue in addition to the 3 regular issues annually. The journal's acceptance rate is about 25%.

Editors need people to contact owners to domain name for Rural Educator, UNLV because it appears above current, correct site for the journal on Bing.

The journal still needs photographs for covers; the board would love for state affiliates to provide photos.

The committee will write a complimentary letter of support for editors to their Dean for continued university support.

The editors suggested a session at each annual meeting to provide information on submitting and getting published in the journal.

The journal will revise its call to include the research agenda and will revise reviewer forms to include rating on research focused on an identified agenda priority.

The Research/Higher Ed Committee joined the meeting at 4:00, and the two committees discussed the incorporation of the research agenda into the journal. We discussed a number of ways to integrate the work of these committees. One avenue is to alter the general call for the journal and, in part of lit review, authors identify, if at all, which of NREA's research priorities they are addressing with their piece. Reviewers will look at whether the authors are addressing a research priority and how well are they addressing it? We discussed possibility of an online source—perhaps a practitioner magazine or blog site or Research in Practice brief, peer reviewed or a researcher-practitioner focused conversation around different research agenda priorities—to connect research from journal to practice. The joint committees recommend the formation of an ad hoc committee to explore this possibility.

#### 3.16Executive Director Report

Since last year's meeting the executive director has attended state meetings in Pennsylvania, Arkansas, Texas, Indiana, Wisconsin, Missouri, Montana, and Nebraska. He has represented NREA at the National Bullying Summit, two Teach to Lead meetings, with Hobart Harmon and Victoria Schaefer at a meeting with the USDOE to discuss the NREA Rural Research agenda, a Pew Charitable Trust meeting, a Connect Ed meeting in Washington, and the NREAC meeting in Washington. During the year committees: developed a research agenda, reviewed and revised policies, reviewed monthly the website, regular meetings of the executive committee, and the executive director conducted a successful search for a new executive director. NREA has a new affiliate in Iowa, another affiliate in Ohio later this year, the potential reactivation of the Oklahoma group, and the beginning of work on a Kentucky group. The journal will be publishing electronically and an archive website has been developed. Priorities for next year include the transition of executive directors, moving materials to a new site, and continued implementation of the research agenda.
