Tax Credit Donation for Snowflake School District



Arizona law (ARS 43-1098.01) Form 322 on the government website: azdor.gov. A credit for cash contributions made, and for certain fees paid to an Arizona public school may be claimed in the year the donation was made **OR** if donation is paid between Jan. 1st and April 15th, you can choose to claim it either in the previous year or the current year. The credit is equal to the amount contributed or the amount of fees paid. For a single taxpayer or head of household, the credit cannot exceed \$200. For married taxpayers that file a joint return, the credit cannot exceed \$400. If married taxpayers file separate returns, each spouse may claim only ½ of the credit that would have been allowed on a joint return. To qualify for the credit, you must make contributions or pay fees to a public school for support of extra-curricular activities or for character education programs. You cannot claim both a tax credit and an itemized deduction for the amount of contributions made to a public school for which you are claiming a credit.
