Dear Families,

Hello! I am writing this letter to inform you of the latest news at St. James School. You may also find this letter on our St. James School Website.

- On Tuesday, January 3, 2017, Mrs. Barrette's Grade 1 class didn't have any heat in the classroom. After several attempts, Siemens Mechanical Services were called and attempted to repair the heating issue. In the meantime, Mrs. Barrette's class spent the day in the Religious Education classroom which was warmer for the students and faculty. The heating issue wasn't repaired but the company returned on Wednesday and repaired the heating issue.
- Mr. Fiore, our Diocesan Superintendent, indicated that Catholic School Week will begin at the end of January. This year our theme is the following: 'Catholic Schools Week: Communities of Faith, Knowledge, and Service'. It will begin with a 9 AM mass on Sunday, January 29, 2017 and end on Friday, February 2, 2017. A list of activities for parents, students and staff will be forthcoming.

No date has been scheduled for this parent meeting.

- Bishop Cote will be visiting St. James School on January 12, 2017. He will be arriving approximately 9:15 AM and will be visiting with Father John, faculty and students.
- On January 13, 2017, faculty members will be trained by Bryan Danek on our Plus Portal Software Program. It is an early dismissal day for professional development. Extended Day Program will be available in the PM.
