Conscious Discipline is an evidence-based emotional regulation program for all ages. They gained information on how to help create a safe and enriching environment in order to develop a child's or student's social, emotional and problem-solving skills in the classroom.

Our school band will also perform at the school play. The full band will perform at the beginning and during intermission, while students who are not participating in the play will perform during scene changes.
