

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES for 2016 - 2017

The following sports are available at Snowflake High School:

Boys Sports: Baseball, Basketball, Cross Country, Football, Golf, Soccer, Track, and Wrestling.

Girl Sports: Basketball, Cheerleading, Cross Country, Soccer, Softball, Track, and Volleyball

Other Activities: ACADEC, Choir, Jazz Band, Marching Band, and Orchestra

Students participating in any extracurricular activity must obtain a white card from the High Schools AD office. The white card is given to the coach on the first day of practice and informs the coach that the participant has met all the requirements to participate. A student will not be allowed to practice without a white card. Requirements for obtaining a white card are as follows:

1. Preparticipation Physical Evaluation Form – filled out by parent and student (Physicals dated after March 2012)
2. Physical from a licensed health care personnel – one required per school year
3. Statement of insurance coverage (If the student is not covered by insurance, the school has forms available to apply for coverage with an independent company for a minimal charge)
4. Activities Code of Conduct Contract indicating that both the student and parent are aware of rules of conduct for athletes.
5. Copy of an official birth certificate (Only need one on file for his/her high school career)
6. Students must be passing all classes (The district has a no pass, no play policy)
7. \$40 participation fee must be paid. This fee is a tax donation to the school and will be refunded by the state upon filing the proper form with the state income tax return.
9. An activity card must be purchased – cost \$25
10. New paperwork needs to be completed only once for each school year, but a fee must be paid and a white card issued for each activity in which the student will be participating.

There is a \$400 cap per family on participation fees only. (The fee for the activity card is not included.) It is the responsibility of each family to keep track of receipts to verify that the \$400 limit has been reached.

If a student tries out for a team where cuts are made and the student is cut from the team, he/she can receive a refund for the participation fee only or transfer the fee to another sport, but it must be done during the current sport season he/she was cut from. If a student pays the participation fee and then quits the team after the team's first game, the participation fee will not be refunded.

Extracurricular Sport Starting Dates:

Football practice for all levels of team will start on July 25, 2016

Cheerleading, Boys/Girls Cross Country, Boys/Girls Soccer and Volleyball will start August 8, 2016

Boys/Girls Basketball and Wrestling practice will start October 31, 2016

Baseball, Golf, Softball, and Track practice will start February 6, 2017

The Activities office will be open most days from 9:00 – 3:00 Monday through Thursday all summer.
