Below is a **tentative** list of upcoming senior events and many will require deposits and or payments:

- Drape pictures for the yearbook AND composite will be held the following days:
  - o Senior girls- Thursday, August 13
  - O Senior guys- Friday, August 14

A deposit of \$30 will be required; please make checks to Addy Photography.

- -Guys will need to bring a white t-shirt, white button shirt and dark tie.
- -Girls will need to wear spaghetti strap shirts under their regular tops.
  - Senior **T-shirts**,  $\sim$  \$11-13 (depending on size), place order by **Sept. 18** (see Mr. Langford)
  - College Night is Tuesday, August 25th, 6:00 PM, The Inn at Ole Miss
  - **Diploma Fee** is \$20 and due by **September 30** to Mrs. Maples in the Counseling Center
  - All **AP testing** payments are due by **October 30** at a cost of **\$91** per test. Taking the test is a requirement of the AP classes. A test <u>will not</u> be ordered for you unless payment is made. Please see the counseling center if you need to set up a payment plan.
  - The Graduation Invitation salesman will be here for a showing in October and orders will be placed in early November. At that time you will be required to pay your deposits for invitations AND your cap and gown. The cap and gown generally costs approximately \$60. Additionally, should you choose to order invitations or additional merchandise, an \$80 deposit is required.
  - The next four dates and deadlines for taking the 2015-16 ACT are below. The cost is \$39.50 for non-writing and \$56.50 for writing. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU TAKE IT EARLY TO LEAVE ROOM FOR IMPROVEMENT IF NEEDED!!!
