- Three or more letters of recommendation: Two from MUHS faculty and at least one from an outside source not related to the applicant.
- Unofficial transcript.

Deadline: Bring your completed application materials to the Counseling office no later

than March 31st (or, if that falls on a weekend or a school holiday, then by

the close of the previous school day). Applicants may be interviewed;

financial need may be evaluated.
