Ms. Laurie Roland, School Board President, called to order the study session of the QCUSD Governing Board for discussion regarding budget reduction updates and SmartSchool's contracts 4:35 p.m. on April 15, 2014.

2. Judah Nativio made a motion to approve agenda with a change to agenda item number 7.2 to show Denise Johnson, NBJH Principal, will be making the presentation. Ken Brague seconded. The motion passed with a vote of 4-0.

- 3. TABLED: Discussion and review of QCUSD Board Evaluation, BAA, BAA-E to be tabled until the May 6, 2014, study session.
- 4. Presentation on the land at Orchard Ranch. The land was donated to the district by the Town of Queen Creek. Mr. Lindsey told the Board that school land cannot be sold without voter approval first. The agreement requires that a school be built on that site.

We have used 7 acres of the property where the District Office and Aquatic Center sit.

Candy Cooley reported to the Board she has the original warranty and the district had 96 months to build a school on the property or it went back to the Town of Queen. All the staff members who drew up this agreement are not with the district any longer.

Candy Cooley asked if the Board wanted her to go back to the town and reopen the agreement and ask for another 96 month extension. The school district still does the maintenance on the property and this is the only piece of land in the district south of the district for an elementary school.

The warranty doesn't say what kind of school and the Board might want to consider building an alternative school at that location. Mr. Lindsey said there are lots of potential options, including a two story building.

Candy Cooley told the Board the district spend approximately \$1,000 a year on maintaining the property.

Mr. Nativio recommended going back to the Town of Queen Creek and ask if we could build something different on the property.

Candy Cooley will contact the Town and she will follow up and come back to the Board with a report.

5. Discussion on timetable of possible school district elections:

A. Governing Board Members

Mr. Lindsey stated that there will be three Board members positions open for the November election.

Mr. Nativio was appointed and that will be a two year term. Mr. Caron and Mr. Brague will both be a four year term. The QCUSD election includes the Mesa area of the school district too.

Candidates will have to collect 75 signatures each and must file their petition with signatures beginning July 7, 2014 and the final day to file is August 6, 2014.

B. Override/Bond/Leases

Regarding bond and override elections, the Board has to give the State notice of intent to hold an election by June 7, 2014. See complete schedule that was handed out.

Shari Zara said there could be a bond/override/capital override election. The RFP lease payment could go to 10 years or if the Board wanted it to go longer, it has to go out for an election to get voter approval.

Laure Roland informed the Board members that once the resolution is submitted the district is limited on what information can be given to the public.

Mr. Judah feels that another override election will be hard, but if the district built a school in the northern area of the district results might be better. We would have to see what the voters wanted.

Laurie Roland stated that she didn't feel the district needed to hire an analysis again this year. Maybe the PTO can encourage people to register to vote.

Shari Zara said that there is a spot on the district's web site where people can click and register to vote. Laurie Roland expressed concern that parents aren't looking at the web site.

Ken Brague said that people don't want to pay more taxes. The district needs to look at how and what we say.

Mr. Lindsey commented that the district can give straight facts. Parents will have to decide what they want the district to be.

Maria Silva told the Board that in the adult ed classes the teachers talk to the students about registering to vote and how important voting is. The teachers will help to get them registered.

Mr. Lindsey explained to the Board that the capital override is the like as an override. It's good for seven years and can be used to purchase equipment and also make lease payments. It is limited, you have to state the dollar amount of the payment will be for each year. If the RFP went through later this evening, it would guarantee payments would be made for seven years.

Review of the 2005, 2010, and Capital bonds by Ms. Zara. Candy Cooley is putting together a critical needs list for the next five years for the district. Mr. Nativio asked if Ms. Zara tracked other districts and what percentage they are at and how much they are bonding out.

Candy Cooley informed the Board that SFB does still exist, but that no money is going through the department. Only money for emergencies is being approved.

The Lease purchase option could be paid through the bond. Wendy Baggs asked about a rolling lease.

JOB GOAL:	To provide training in interventions for teachers, to ensure grade level proficiency in reading and math for secondary students and to compile Galileo and AIMS data to assist classrooms teachers in Mastery of Standards of Grade Level Standards.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

Responsibilities shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

District-level Responsibilities:

- 1. Maintain leadership and involvement within Galileo Assessment Group (GAG).
- 2. Analyzes scores forGalileo benchmark tests, AIMS, PARCC, etc.
- 3. Prepares data notebook and updates regularly. Lead and conduct data team meetings with administration and teachers. Meets with Assistant Superintendent of

- Student Achievement and district level coordinators as needed.
- 4. Attend quarterly intervention meeting with assistant superintendent.
- 5. Compile reports as needed and communicate strengths and needs to site and district-level personnel.
- 6. Assists District level coordinators and assistant superintendent as needed.
- 7. Attends curriculum and data meetings and trainings as needed.
- 8. Assists with the PARCC (or other state tests) before, during, and after testing. This will include events such as, but not limited to uploading student information, watching training videos, coordinating with site technology person, principal and district-level personnel for successful implementation of testing.

School-level Responsibilities:

- 1. Use data from standardized tests, classroom grades, Measures of Academic Progress (MAP), and curriculum based measures to identify at-risk students in Reading & Math, and secondarily, all Galileo tested areas.
- 2. Knowledge of state standards and assist teachers to more effectively teach and evaluate those standards.
- 3. Maintain an in-depth knowledge of the AZ Common Core Math curriculum standards.
- 4. Maintain an in-depth knowledge of AZ/Common Core ELA curriculum standards.
- 5. Analyze data to determine those students who need remediation, re-teaching or tutoring programs.
- 6. Use the data to find likely candidates for any/all of those programs listed above.
- 7. Assist with remediation, re-teaching, or tutoring programs.
- 8. Understand and lead PLC initiative within school.
- 9. Observe and assist classroom teachers in areas necessary for improved academic success of students.
- 10. Assists with the GAG group responsibilities (i.e. coordination of test administration for Galileo benchmarks, AIMS, etc)
- 11. Evaluates the performance of students regarding achievements in curriculum and

- activities and advises the classroom teacher on making necessary provisions to meet learning needs.
- 12. Attend regularly scheduled instructional team leader meetings and participate as a member of the team to promote learning activities for students consistent with district and school education objectives.
- 13. Coordinate with the school principal and department chairs a schedule to accommodate identified students in the reteach and enrich system.
- 14. Attend training sessions as the principal directs.
- 15. Provide instruction to small groups of at-risk students as directed by the principal.
- 16. Work closely with teachers to coordinate efforts of the intervention program with the regular classroom to promote student success.
- 17. Maintain required data on individual student progress and disseminates data to principal, teachers, and parents.
- 18. Collaborates with the principal and assistant principal in all areas of testing.
- 19. Provide technical support as needed by building principal.
- 20. Assess students frequently, examine student assessment data, and refine intervention activities to address individual student needs.
- 21. Perform other duties as assigned by the principal.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- 1. In addition to the physical and mental capabilities implied by the responsibilities detailed above, the essential functions of the specialist include: reading, writing, hearing and speaking effectively, and analyzing data. Specialist must be organized and able to create a rigorous and respectful learning environment.
- 2. The job of specialist involves adapting to a changing educational environment and therefore, while accurate, is not inclusive.

11. Presentation and discussion of overview of March 2014 budget by Shari Zara, CFO.

Ms. Zara reviewed the totals from the March 2014 District Budget Report. The M&O budget was adopted in July 2013. The balance at the end of the month was \$7.67M dollars and there is an encumbrance of \$7.535M dollars of PO's and salaries to be paid until June 30th. That will leave a budget balance of \$144,250.

610 is unrestricted capital which we have a balance of \$1,658M dollars and an encumbrance of \$53,617. That will leave the district with a balance of \$1,604M dollars.

Mr. Nativio asked about the unrestricted capital outlay balance and if any of this was bond money.

Ms. Zara explained, per recommendations, the district carries a three year unrestricted capital balance. Funds are transferred over to M&O each year.

The district has built up the fund to help pay for repairs at the middle school.

There is no more soft capital and this is also were we purchase textbooks and materials for students.

This is just capital, which is separate from bond.
