Dear Parents and/or Guardians,

Queen Creek Unified School District has a no charge lunch policy. Students who do not have enough money to cover the **complete** cost of the lunch will be given an alternate meal that consists of a cheese or peanut butter sandwich on whole wheat bread, a serving of fruit and a carton of milk. Please be advised that the cafeteria will use a smiley face hand stamp with elementary and middle school students and verbally remind Junior High and High School students at the point of sale. These practices will start when there is approximately 4 days worth of lunches left on the account. Student meal prices are: *Breakfast* – No charge for students who qualify for free or reduced meals otherwise \$1.15; *Lunch* – No charge for students who qualify for reduced meals otherwise \$2.50 for K-6th grade students and \$3.00-\$3.25 for 9-12th grade students.

There are several ways to pay for your child's meals. Parents may send money with their child in the form of cash, check (\$25 returned check fee) or money order to be paid directly to the cafeteria. Payment may also be made online at *http://family.titank12.com/* using Visa, MasterCard or Discover (a transaction fee of \$2.50 will be applied to online payments). Parents/guardians may contact the school cafeteria at any time during business hours or use *http://family.titank12.com/* free of charge 24 hours per day to check the balance of your child's account and/or to view the daily meal transactions. You may also set up free email reminders for low balances online; the website will work with any cell phone web browser as well.
