Pre-School year begins September 7, 2016!

Pre-School will be held on MONDAYS AND WEDNESDAYS from 8AM to 4PM. We are excited to have Courtney Bell as the Pre-School teacher this year. Any child who is 3 TO 5 YEARS OLD, POTTY TRAINED, AND COMMITTED TO ATTEND ON A REGULAR BASIS is eligible to be enrolled. All enrolled are to follow the school handbook, including dress code.

Enrollment: Parents must provide the school with the following:

- ✓ Birth certificate
- ✓ Current immunization record
- ✓ Completed preschool registration forms (enclosed)

Breakfast/Lunch Program: We are going to have breakfast for the students again this year at no cost. Breakfast will include cereal, crackers, juice, milk, and/or occasionally something prepared by the cook. Students will need to go to the cafeteria **before** school starts in the morning to have breakfast. Students will not receive breakfast after the first bell rings because the cook will begin preparing lunch. Lunch meal prices will remain the same at \$1.00 for Pre-K, \$1.75 for grades K-6, \$2.00 for grades 7-12, and \$5.00 for Visitors. Please call the office in the morning if you would like to have lunch with your child.
