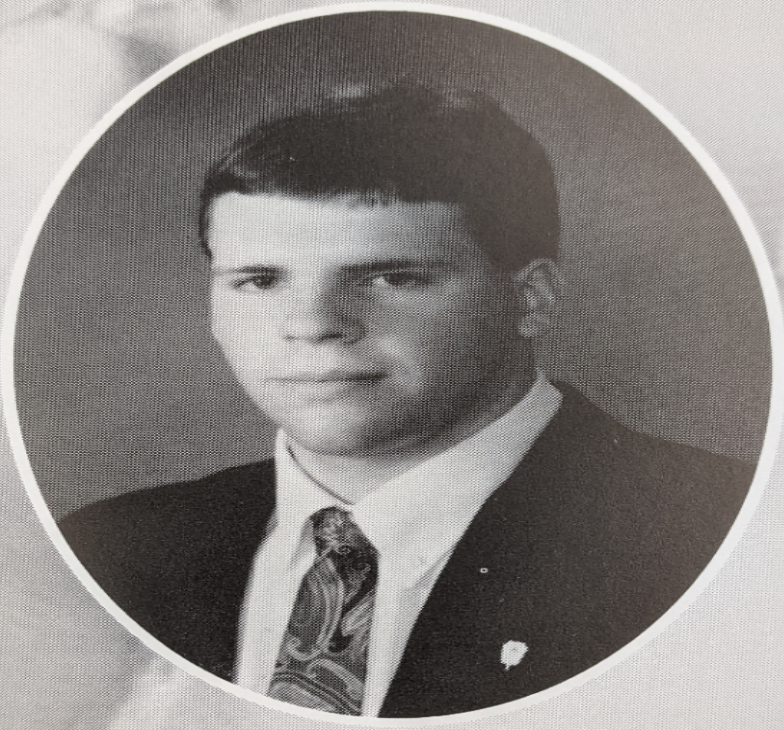
I tended to gravitate toward the coaches and the other teachers that would joke around with us a bit.
