

Western Reserve Athletic Booster Club Scholarship

Following are the provisions set forth by the Scholarship Rules Committee for the “Annual Athletic Scholarship Awards” to be presented to seniors by the Western Reserve Athletic Booster Club.

1. Selection for recipients is to be made by the Scholarship Committee.
2. Recipient must have achieved at least one varsity letter.
3. Recipients grade point average **MAY** be considered.
4. Make a written application through the Athletic Director or Guidance Counselor by an annually stated deadline.
5. Confirmation of enrollment in the participant’s school or college of choice must be received by the Booster Club from the high school principal or guidance counselor prior to presentation. (Can be a two or four year college)
6. Scholarships will be awarded after the successful completion of the first fall quarter or semester immediately following high school. Your grades must be turned into the guidance office along with proof of enrollment in the next quarter or semester before funds can be released.
7. The monetary value of this scholarship is to be established on a yearly basis at no more than \$1,000.00 to be broken up into four scholarships. Two for girls and two for boys.
8. Scholarship Committee will consist of:
 - a. Booster Club President
 - b. Athletic Director
 - c. Two members of the WR Athletic Booster Club
 - d. 2 designated members of the coaching staff.*

*To be appointed by the Booster Club President.
