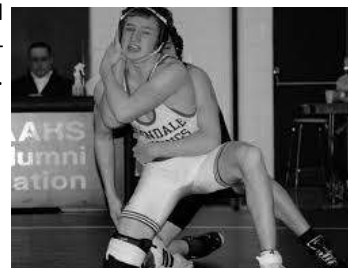
Meet Dalton Gondek

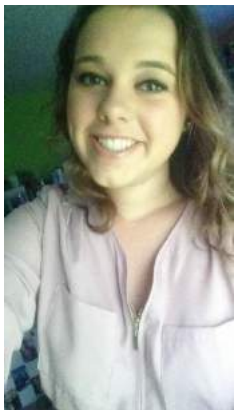
My favorite subject in school is math because I enjoy working with numbers. Reading is my least favorite subject because it is boring and I just tend to stare at a book.

In my family I have three sisters, Coollette, Corrin, and Carissa. I then have a little brother named Chandler. I'm sharing my high school years with my two sis

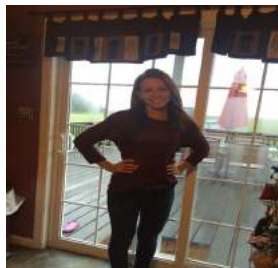


ters, Coollette and Corrin. Also, included in the family, I have two animals a dog named Sadie and a cat named Smokes. My family helps and

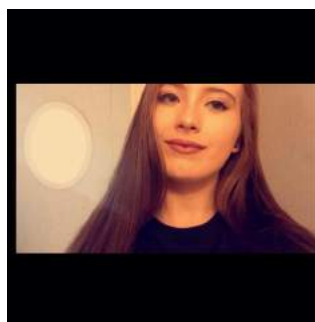
My favorite subject in school is English, and my least favorite is math. I've been in the marching band for six

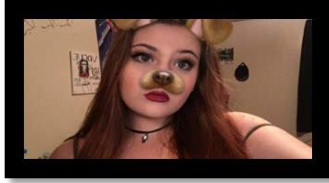
everyone, they make some great bops.

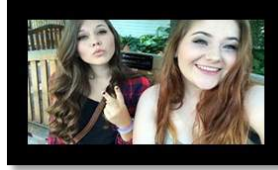
Once I graduate high school I'd like to further my education at Slippery Rock University, studying social work and human behavior.

when people ask how old I am and are surprised by how good I am for my age.



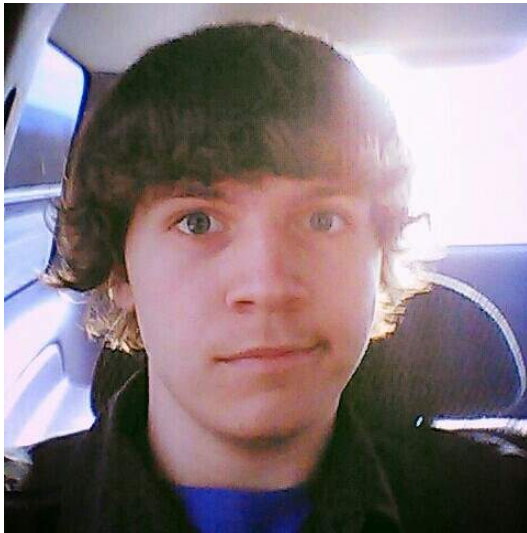
