Uniform Agreement and Instructions

You have been issued a school owned uniform and are now expected to adhere to the following responsibilities and instructions:

1. **DO NOT WASH THE UNIFORM – PROFESSIONAL DRY CLEAN ONLY!**
2. Do not store wet uniforms in garment bags. Hang properly and allow to air dry. Do not tumble dry or heat a wet uniform garment piece in any way.
3. Do not contact uniform garments with any topical chemicals such as spot cleaning chemicals, waterproofs, bleach, spray deodorants, hair spray, perfumes and makeup.
4. Examine the uniform garment after each use for soiling, stains, etc. Have uniform dry cleaned as needed.
5. Abnormally stained uniform garments should be cleaned by a professional dry cleaner as soon as possible. Do not attempt to hand clean. Perspiration destroys fabrics. Have the garment cleaned. Note: Time tends to stain. Have the uniform cleaned sooner rather than later.
6. When not being worn, the uniform must be kept in a garment bag at all times. Be sure a nametag appears on your garment bag.
7. The Glendale Band Boosters are responsible for all alterations. Please notify any Band Booster officer with questions or concerns.
8. If uniform pants are too long they must be hemmed. If students walk on the bottom of their pants a hole will wear in them.
9. Please note that it is unnecessary to dry clean the uniform before it is turned in at the end of the year, as they will be cleaned over the summer.
10. Please be sure that you have all parts of your uniform when going to a performance. If any parts are missing you will not be permitted to perform.
11. **BAND MEMBER MUST WEAR BLACK SOCKS AND BLACK SHOES WITH THE UNIFORM. BLACK SNEAKERS ARE NOT PERMITTED.**

12. At no time should jeans or sweat pants be worn under the uniform. Nylon gym shorts or lycra pants may be worn under the pants and a t-shirt can be worn under the jacket. In the event of cold weather thermal underwear should be worn.

Important: Please be advised that the repair or replacement cost of any lost or damaged uniform parts will be the responsibility of the students parent's or guardian. If there is a problem or question about the uniform please contact the band director or a band booster officer.

Please remember: At all times – Please wear ALL of your uniform or NONE of it!!
