 - HHC will hold a pizza party the last day on March 30, 2017
 - Students report with homework to the Elementary Library
 - Certified Teachers help students with homework
 - Computer Lab available per teacher's discretion
 - Must PICK UP CHILD AT 4:20 pm
 - Permission slips are MANDATORY
 - BLUE permission slip is used to attend daily sessions
 - Must send each day the child is to attend HHC
 - Please complete entire form including phone number
 - Additional slips available upon request
 - ORANGE permission slip is used ONCE for ENTIRE year
 - One slip per child
 - This permission slip gives permission to attend HHC each session
 - Forms due by Thursday, September 8, 2016
 - Attached is a BLUE permission slip and an ORANGE permission slip for your convenience.
