Pick-Up & Drop-Off Information

Most of the campuses in Tulare City School District have parking issues and Pleasant has had its share at one time or another. To avoid these problems, I want to inform you on where you can park and/or drop off your students before school and after school.

Campus Access

<u>The campus is closed until 7:45am</u>. If your student arrives at 7:45, they are to report to the cafeteria. The main gates near the office will be open from 7:45 until 8:30 each day. They will reopen at 2:20 each day. Between the hours of 8:30 and 2:20 you will only be able to gain access to the campus by going into the main office.

Parking & Walking

You can park on any street around the school (Milner Street or Pleasant Street) as long as you don't block access to the school parking lot or the neighborhood drive-ways. If you park on a red curb your vehicle will be towed away.

Parking in either of the school parking lots is for school business only or handicap parking. Do not park and walk into campus. You will be required to move your vehicle.

Students who live in the immediate area around Pleasant Elementary are encouraged to walk or ride their bike to school (wearing a helmet). If your child does walk or ride their bike to school we also encourage them to do so with a friend or relative.

Buses

Buses arrive in the east parking lot and students are picked-up for the bus in the east parking lot in the afternoon. Do not block or drop off students in this parking lot.

Car Drop-Offs/Pick-ups

If you are dropping your student off and picking them up, you can do so on Milner Street (north of the school). Please pull near the gate before allowing your students in or out of your car and be careful when pulling back onto the street.

You may also drop-off and pick-up in the main parking lot. There are two lanes that cars can get into and staff members will help students in or out of the cars once the car reaches the cross walk. Do not get out of your vehicle or park in the main parking lot. Your car will be removed. You can enter this parking lot through the north entrance off of Milner and exit onto Pleasant.

I hope this update helps you plan accordingly with the dropping off and picking up of your student. Please remember Character Counts and hopefully we will not have any parking issues. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the office at 685-7300.

Lunch Payments

Tulare City School District continues to maintain a **NO CHARGE** policy for meal accounts. Therefore, please have monies available in advance for your child. Payments may be made daily, weekly or monthly in the school office. You may also pay online through our district EZ School Pay Program. Please be sure to complete a meal application for your child. Applications are available in the school office.

Child Pick-Up

Remember to pick up your child on time.

The City of Tulare offers "Best Club" on our campus for parents who need after school care for their children (paid program at the City of Tulare).

The Choices Program is also available for our 2nd-5th grade students (on a first come, first serve basis only). Flyers are available in the school office.

Attendance

It is very important to get your child to school on time. The first bell rings at 8:15 am. The tardy bell rings at 8:20 am. If your child is absent, please call the school office as soon as possible and provide a doctor's note whenever possible. Let's keep Pleasant one of the highest rated schools for attendance percentages!
