Betty White, she inspires me to have great longevity, to be funny and give the gift of laughter.

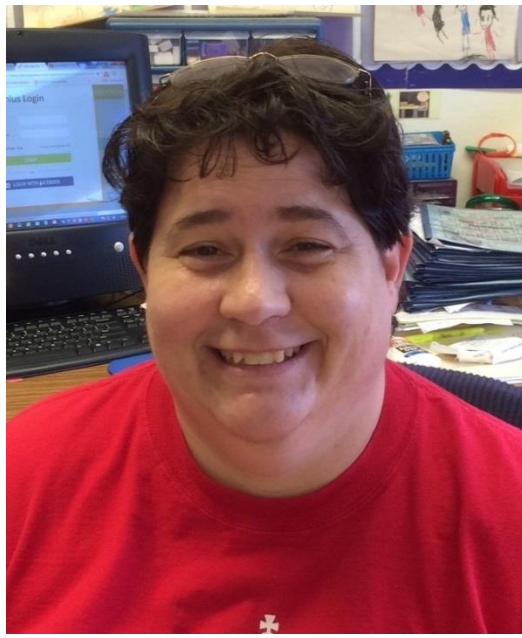
What would you do (for a career) if you weren't doing this?
