Corcoran High School Clubs

CSF: College Scholarship Federation- Meets twice a month, you must have a GPA of 3.8 and above to be a member. Two year members graduate in white. Members raise money and go on field trips. Members must pay \$4.00 dues every semester in order to graduate in white; this is the member's responsibility.

FFA: Future Farmers of America- Officers meet once a week, with a large meeting once month. There are constant activities, many field trips and fundraising. This club is open to students that are enrolled in at least one Agriculture course.
